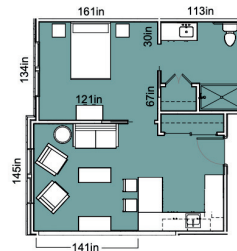
March 2026: Construction begins

Fall 2026: Brick and stone applications, exterior painting, HVAC and other equipment

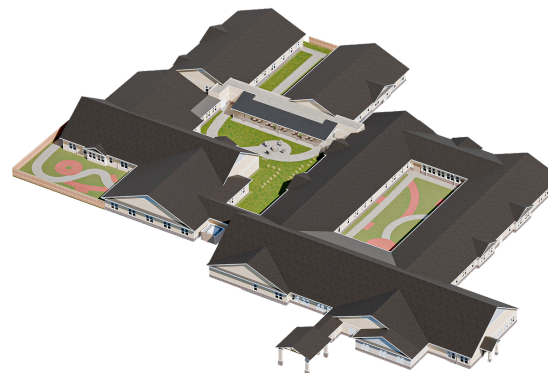
Winter 2026: Interior finishes, flooring, countertops and millwork.
